Reading Assignments for September 2017

September 6 Topic: The Cross

Pennock: Read page 53, 64-68, Catechism of the Catholic Church: Paragraph 613-618, 1435

Reflect on these questions: Jesus is the Savior of the world. What does it mean for you to say, "Jesus saves me". What sacrifice do you make now for the good of family, friends, work? Is God calling you to sacrifice/conversion in other ways?

September 13 Topic: Conversion

Pennock: Read page 211, 278-279, CCC: 1431-33, 1439

Reflect on these questions: We participate in Jesus' "Paschal Mystery", i.e., dying to old and rising to new life, each time we are challenged by the need to go through a change and move to a new way of living. This 'new way' of being and finding the good that comes of it happens because of God's grace, presence in our life. Think of a time when you had to make a change and found that the new way of living was evidence of God operating in your life. Journal that experience.

September 24 Topic: Forgiveness

Catechism of the Catholic Church: Read Paragraph 1468-1470

Reflect on these questions: What in my life needs to be forgiven? Do I need to forgive myself? Why would that be important? How is reconciliation and forgiveness related?

September 27 Topic: Sacrament of Penance

Pennock: Read page 209-216

Reflect on these questions: What did I think I knew about this sacrament? What understanding has changed because of reading these readings?
