Reading Assignments for October 2017

October 4 Topic: Moral Decision Making

Pennock: Read page 247-257

Reflection on these questions:

Have you ever had discussions about what makes up an evil act? How did the explanation of the components of evaluating if an action is evil (pages 248-249) help you better understand this process? What are the biggest factors that went into forming your conscience? Sin is a failure to love God, yourself and your neighbor: does this change how you view 'sin'? Map out the steps you have taken to make moral decisions.

October 11 Topic: Divine Justice/Forgiveness

Reflect on these questions:

Name occasions of grace in your life. What specific ways, events or people have been sources of grace in your life? Did they change the way you view life, relationships, God? Based on your readings, write your definition of 'justification'.

How can the commandments help you to love God, your neighbor and yourself? How would you begin to think about the sacrament of Reconciliation based on last month's presentation and this week's readings?
