## **RCIA Continuing Education Assignments for February 2019**

### **Feb 6 Topic: Real Presence in the Eucharist**

*Reflect on these questions:*

What are your thoughts, feelings, and reservations about the belief that Jesus is really present in what looks like bread and wine? This teaching of the Catholic Church ultimately comes from Jesus's words at the Last Supper, "This is my body...Take and eat... blood... drink." Are you affected at all by the "creepiness factor" that some people feel when learning about the Eucharist?

### **Feb 13 Topic: Apostolic Succession/Magisterium & Anointing of the Catechumens**

Apostolic Succession has been called "Catholic 6 degrees of separation." How does it feel to be part of a community that has a direct line all the way back to the Apostles and Jesus Christ himself? When you get confirmed, the authority that calls down the Holy Spirit upon you comes from the Bishop, who gets it from his ordination by other bishops, going all the way back to the Apostles themselves. What impact does the connection of your Confirmation to the Apostles have on you?

### **Feb 20 Topic: Liturgy: Why do we do that?**

How does understanding the rituals described and explained today help you understand the Mass better?
