Dear Nativity Catholic School Families,

Nativity Catholic School, in partnership with the Diocese of St. Petersburg, is continuing to follow the guidance from the CDC and public health organizations as we make decisions about how best to move forward with regard to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). This memo supersedes the earlier one sent on Friday, March 13 *by extending the closure of Catholic Schools through March 27.*

After prayerful consideration, Bishop Parkes has directed that all Catholic schools and Early Childhood center buildings will be closed to students from Monday, March 16 through Friday, March 27. The schedule for March and April is as follows:

March 16 – No School for Students and Faculty

March 17 – Teacher Professional Development Day for Remote Learning Preparation

March 18 – Virtual Remote Learning Practice Day for Students

March 19 & 20 – Virtual Remote Learning School Days with Teachers and Students

March 23-27 – No School for Students and Faculty. We will be using the days off from Easter vacation to give our teachers and students a mental and physical break.

March 30 and after– Normal School Days or Virtual Remote Learning Days with Teachers and Students. The determination of the type of school day will be based on DOSP, State and Federal Guidance.

April 10 – Good Friday; No School for Students and Faculty

April 13-17 –Normal School Days or Virtual Remote Learning Days, Spring Break has been moved to March 23-27.

Let us continue to pray for one another and remain calm in the peace of Christ during this time.
